

MINUTES OF A MEETING OF THE SOUTH NEWTON AND STOFORD PARISH COUNCIL

1. Election of Chairman and Vice Chairman

a. Vote for Chairman

The Clerk requested nominations for Chairman, Cllr H. Bryans proposed Cllr. D. Blake to continue as Chairman, this was seconded by Cllr. K. Norman. Cllr D. Blake accepted nomination and Councillors present voted unanimously to elect Cllr. D. Blake.

b. Vote for Vice-Chairman

Clerk requested nominations for Vice- Chairman, Cllr. K. Norman proposed Cllr. N. Blake seconded by Cllr. H. Swanton. Councillors present again voted unanimously to elect Cllr N. Blake.

It was agreed by all Councillors to continue in 2018-19 year.

c. Apologies. – Apologies were received from Cllr. C. Swanton, Cllr R. Botten and Cllr M. Pont who were unable to attend.

2. Minutes of Previous meeting:

Minutes of meeting held on Wednesday 4th April 2018 were approved and signed by the Chairman Cllr. D. Blake.

3. Any matters arising:

a. Parking lines Oak Close and Jubilee Close, South Newton – Clerk has emailed S. Harris W.C.C. the Request has been passed to Environmental Works for further action.

b. Parking of Caravans on Car Parks, South Newton – Clerk has emailed S. Harris W.C.C. Enforcement order has been issued to owner to remove caravan by end of June 2018 from current location.

c. Football pitch and basketball net – Vale View Road Play Area – Clerk confirmed order has been placed 2-3 weeks delivery.

d. Community Speed Indicator device – Cllr. R. Botten not present will discuss at next meeting. Still awaiting delivery of S.I.D.'s

e. Drain at Stoford Bus Stop – Continuing to monitor.

f. Signage on A 36 - Glenside Manor – Clerk confirmed Highways to pass to 3rd party schemes team. Awaiting their response.

g. Narrow footpath to mill at South Newton – Cllr H. Swanton confirmed will check with Cllr. C. Swanton about when work will happen to fill in narrow areas.

h. Overhanging branches – Stoford – Cllr. R. Botten not present, awaiting response from S.S.E.

i. Beach Hedge St. Andrews Road South Newton – Now cut. No further action.

j. New Bins and gravel for pathway – Cllr. D. Blake confirmed he is to locate a new bin and will install at the entrance to Vale View Playground.

4. **Wiltshire Councillor's Report –**

- Wilton Parkway – A new quotation based on a lower cost option is being obtained, possible cost between £10-£12 million pounds and the project is still looking very positive
- C283 – This was confirmed as a number 1 priority due to HGV use of road. Discussions with CATG to ensure best possible outcome, including repair of potholes more extensively, resurface and relining of junction at A36-C283 (£4,000) to be done A.S.A.P. We are also awaiting a Freight Assessment which Area Cllr. Pauline Church will chase urgently.
- Cllr. Church confirmed that Wiltshire Council are in the process of re-adjustment of boundaries.
- Strategic meeting Salisbury – The Free Parking in Salisbury is continuing with changes to times 12 noon onwards now each day and free on Saturday and Sunday.
- Wishford Road – It was confirmed that engineers believe it is in a reasonable condition.
