2. Minutes of Previous meeting:

- a) Parking lines Oak Close and Jubilee Close, South Newton – Clerk has emailed S. Harris W.C.C. the request has been passed to Environmental Works.

- g) New Bins and gravel for pathway – Cllr. D. Blake will source new bins.
- h) Quotations for work Vale View Road Play area – Cllr. N. Blake investigating funding of work.

- Wilton Parkway – this project continues to move forward. Awaiting report on the Rail Strategy for Swindon and Wiltshire which includes Wilton.
- The C283 remains a priority and we are still pushing for a weight restriction.
- Salisbury Novichok – Areas of Salisbury are still being very comprehensively tested. The effect on Local businesses has been detrimental and plans are in process to support and improve Salisbury.
